Challenges

- 
- ☐ It is easily committed
 - ☐ It is cheap for the criminal
 - ☐ It is anonymous, since the criminal does not have to reveal his identity
 - ☐ It is fast and leaves only digital traces
 - ☐ The criminal does not have to leave his home places to connect
 - ☐ It can be hard to locate to cover their traces since criminals operate in various countries
